LIFE MEMBERSHIP NOMINATION FORM

In accordance with the constitution, Life Membership of the Happy Valley Bowling Club Inc may be conferred on any member or individual who has rendered distinguished and outstanding service to the club. A Life Member will have demonstrated significant, sustained and high-quality involvement enhancing the reputation and future of the club.

To be considered for Life Membership by the Club Board, any nomination must meet the all of following criteria -

- 1. <u>Minimum of 10 years of continuous membership</u> an exception to the rule may be made if the person being nominated has given an outstanding contribution for a shorter period of not less than seven years, <u>prior</u> to a severe medical condition that prevents their further involvement.
- 2. <u>Plus a major contribution to the club in a leadership role</u> (not necessarily on Board) this could include but is not limited to
 - o significant input and service as a Board member
 - o a long-term role in one or more capacities, such as
 - Night Owls Co-Ordinator
 - Providore/Catering Manager
 - Grounds Manager
 - Bar Manager or Bar Committee Member
 - Sponsorship / Fundraising Coordinator
 - Tournaments Manager
 - Manager of Come & Try Days and other community outreach events
 - Selection Panel Member
 - Youth Development Manager
 - Coaching, Umpiring and Mentoring
- Plus the nominee will have demonstrated
 - o positive and respectful behaviour
 - o commitment to the principles of good sportsmanship
 - leadership qualities
 - o commitment to the club
 - o and been a noted and valuable role model for others.

Nominations must be made on this form and accompanied by a short citation (100 words minimum) explaining how the nominee meets these criteria. Nominations must be signed and seconded by currently financial voting members of the club and presented to the Board for consideration at least 2 months before the Annual General Meeting or Special General Meeting at which the Life Membership may be presented.

Awarding of a Life Membership is not automatically granted as it must be duly considered by the Board.

Voting will take place by secret ballot and a simple majority will prevail. All ballot slips will be destroyed after the conclusion of the vote.
